



Section C

"My Pet Poster"

Instructions:

- 1. Ask each student to create a poster on their dream pet using drawings and simple sentences.
- 2. Provide each student with a blank sheet of paper or a poster board, coloured pencils or markers, and writing materials.
- 3. Instruct the students to:
 - a. Draw a picture of their dream pet in the centre of the poster.
 - b. Write the name of their dream pet at the top of the poster.
 - c. Write three simple sentences describing why they would like to have that pet.
 - d. Decorate the poster with additional drawings or stickers related to their dream pet.
- 4. Encourage the students to be creative and use their imagination while completing the task.
- 5. Set a deadline for completing the posters and remind students to bring them.
- 6. After the whole class submission, give each student the opportunity to present their pet poster to the class.
- 7. As each student presents, encourage the rest of the class to listen attentively and ask questions or make comments about their friend's dream pet.
- 8. Display the pet posters around the classroom for everyone to appreciate and enjoy.

Section B

Sample Answers:

- 1. If I could have any animal as a pet, I would choose a dog. Dogs are known for their loyalty and companionship, and I find them to be incredibly loving and friendly animals. (Or any suitable answers by students.)
- 2. My favourite animal is a dolphin. It is a beautiful creature with a sleek body, a curved fin, and a friendly face. I like dolphins because they are very intelligent and playful. They are also excellent swimmers and can jump high out of the water. Whenever I see dolphins, it makes me happy and excited. I love their graceful movements and the way they interact with each other. My favourite animal is a panda. I chose a panda because it is black and white, and it looks very cuddly. I like pandas because they are gentle and adorable. They spend most of their time eating bamboo, and they can climb trees too. I think pandas are unique and special animals.
